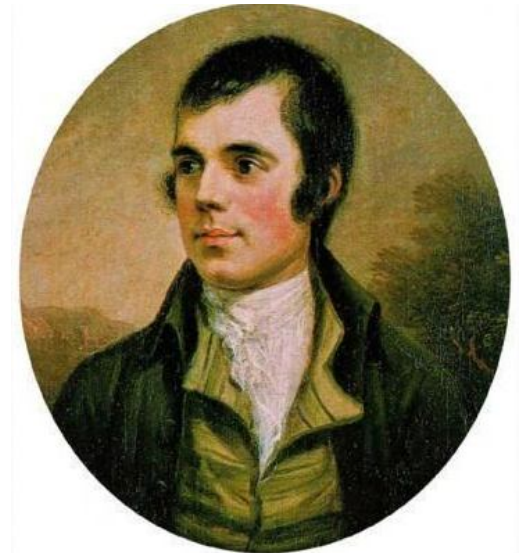

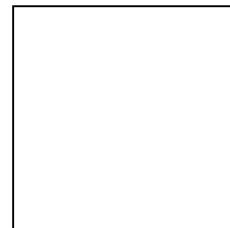

Directions to the Olmsted:

From I-65 South (Indiana)

Take I-65 South over the Kennedy Bridge and make your way onto I-64 East. Follow the signs to Exit 10, 'Cannons Lane'. Make a left onto Cannon's Lane. Follow Cannon's Lane to end on Frankfort Ave. Make a right onto Frankfort Ave. The Masonic Homes and the Olmsted are less than a mile on your left.

From I-65 North

Take I-65 North. Merge onto I-264 (Watterson Expressway). Follow the Watterson until you reach Exit 21b 'Shelbyville Rd' (it's the second exit). Follow Shelbyville Rd. After crossing Breckenridge, keep right as the road becomes Frankfort Ave. The Masonic Homes and the Olmsted are less than a mile on your right.

From I-71 South

Take Exit 2 'Zorn Ave'. Turn left onto Zorn Ave. Zorn becomes Hillcrest Ave. Turn left onto Frankfort Ave. The Masonic Homes and the Olmsted are less than a mile on your left.
